At birth (for babies more likely to come into contact with TB than the general population)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Tuberculosis 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> BCG
At birth (for babies whose mothers are hepatitis B positive)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Hepatitis B 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Hep B
